PEOPLE PROGRAM

The Buttery's CORE Young People Program (CORE-YP)

The Buttery's CORE-YP program offers a comprehensive 7 week day rehabilitation program, complemented by 4 months of aftercare support.

Designed specifically for young people aged 12 to 24, dealing with harmful or problematic alcohol or drug use.

Drawing upon The Buttery's wealth of expertise in treating substance misuse, participation in the CORE-YP program is provided at no cost.

Program Structure

- 7-Week Day Rehabilitation:
 Participants engage in a 7-week, day rehabilitation program, attending group and individual support sessions, two to three days per week.
- 4 months Aftercare:
 Participants receive up to 4 months of aftercare support.

CORE Young People Eligibility

To qualify for the CORE-YP program, participants must:

- Be aged 12 to 24 years old
- Be experiencing harmful alcohol and/or other drug use.
- Demonstrate a willingness to abstain from alcohol and illicit drugs throughout the program.
- Be able to attend face-to-face sessions two to three times per week for 7 weeks.
- Have stable mental health.

Location

The CORE-YP program is offered in 7-week blocks at different locations throughout the Port Macquarie, Birpai Country area.

The program customises interventions and support strategies for two age brackets:

Tailored Groups for Ages 12-17 and 18-24

Our program provides personalised interventions and support strategies tailored for two distinct age groups: 12-17 and 18-24. This ensures that every participant receives a program specifically suited to their unique needs and developmental stage.
