

Unit Name: Inclusive Learning Through Drama

Lesson name: Creating a Character

Stage: 3

Duration: 60 - 90 Minutes

Lesson Overview

Students will explore a variety of dramatic roles in and out of context. Students will use critical and creative thinking skills to develop rich and insightful characters. Students will discuss preconceived ideas and assumptions they hold about others based on a diverse range of characters. Students will be able to construct real life characters through the use of voice skills, movement and gestures.

Lesson Outcomes

A student will learn to:

- take on a range of roles challenging character stereotypes, depicting empathy, different and contrasting attitudes and status
- negotiate and sustain roles and their relationships in shaping the action.

A student will learn about:

- devising, rehearsing and acting in drama using voice and movement skills to convey meaning to an audience
- responding confidently with gesture, movement and voice skills to a range of scripts and other texts to structure the narrative or episodes and build on the action of the drama.

ACTIVITY

Group Activity: Brainstorm Characters

Teacher Note: The following activities will allow students to explore a diverse range of characters that are a reflection of the real world. The teacher's role is to challenge any preconceived ideas or assumptions that students hold about these characters. Though the classroom is a safe space for questions, please ensure all prejudices or stereotypes regarding race, ethnicity, cultural background, language/accent, religion, gender, sexuality or ability etc., are challenged and discussed in a respectful and accepting manner. The focus of the activities is to supersede what makes us different and to focus on our commonalities.

- 1. Each student is provided with a *Drama Character Card*.
- 2. In groups of 3, students brainstorm together about **who** their character/s might be.
- 3. Exploring a variety of possibilities in covering basic profile details:
 - What is the character's name?
 - How old are they?
 - Where do they live?
 - What are some things they like or like doing?
- 4. Teacher can set a timer to give each student 2 minutes to talk about their characters to the group.
- 5. Teacher questions and reflects on the origins of students' thoughts.
 - Why do you think this about this character?
 - Do you know anyone that reminds you of this character?
 - What are some other possibilities about who this character could be?
 - What do you have in common with the character?
 - What do you find interesting about the character?
 - Does this character remind you of anyone you know personally?

Group Activity: Establishing a Character

- Teacher provides students with Creating a Character Questions.
 Adjusted materials: Creating a Character Questions Simplified Version/Creating a Character Drawing.
- 2. In their groups students establish a character profile delving deeper into the character's personality, interests, community, successes/challenges and dreams/goals.
- 3. Students take turns in their groups to share to the class the character they have created. The teacher's role is to challenge any assumptions or stereotypes (if any).



4. Students are given the *Drama Character Card Biographies* and can compare their creation with another version which may add additional or contrasting information for the character.

Reflection:

- Were there any differences between your character profile and the information in the character's biography?
- What were the main similarities or differences?
- Why do you think you thought these things about this character?
- Would you change anything in your character profile now you have read about character?
- Other than your own, can you find another character from the class you like or that you find interesting? Can you tell us why?
- Were you surprised by any facts about your character in their biographies or that a class member created? Why?

Group Activity: Becoming the Character

- 1. Students think about how their character would communicate, move and act.
- 2. Students are given 5 minutes to think about how their character would act in a basic scenario (e.g. buying a bottle of water), focusing the dramatic elements of voice, gesture and movement.
- 3. Students present their character to the class or in their groups.
- 4. Again, students and teachers can question and reflect on students' choices and assumptions in character building.

ASSESSMENT:

There is no formal assessment provided for this activity.

Adaptations, Considerations and/or Adjustments

Note: Think about how this lesson may affect students in your class and make any of these adaptations that you feel necessary. **Physical:** Allow students to create their character using technology, e.g. finding images that represent their character in a photo collage. Students use verbal language to describe how their character would act in the given scenario.

Vision: Provide large font versions of resources *Character Cards - Large Print, Drama*Character Card Biographies - Large Print, Character Card Biographies - Simplified Version
Large Print , Creating a Character Questions, Creating a Character Questions - Simplified

Version and Creating a Character - Drawing. Have students describe how they would act as their character. Provide all questions in verbal forms. Provide a written description of the character card in order for students to use 'Talk to Text'.

Hearing: Provide students with *Creating a Character - Language Support* throughout the lesson for clarification. Teacher can write up students' answers on the board. Ensure students



are presenting their characters to the group in written form, for students to read along while being spoken about.

Sensory: Create a space in the classroom that gives students a 'break' from constant environmental stimulants.

Non-verbal: Allow students to write answers and character profiles. Support students' preferred ways of communication. Incorporating technology or devices in group discussion and asking targeted closed questions, provide specific role in group work, e.g. scribe or organiser.

EAL/D: Provide the <u>Creating a Character - Language Support</u> to students for clarification. Provide adjusted *Creating a Character Questions - Simplified Version* and *Creating a Character - Drawing.*

Other: For performance refusal or avoidance, allow students alternative ways of performing or being involved, such as grouping students in pairs with someone they feel comfortable working with. Students acting may prefer to be filmed and presented to the class via technology. For students who are overwhelmed by working in large groups the character building activities can be changed into a paired activity.


- 1. Make a group of 3-4 students.
